FEEDBACK ON PAVILION PROPOSALS

The proposal has been informed through a village survey, consultation with representatives from current user groups (the cricket and football clubs, the boules group and the Coffee Pot), the requirements of relevant sports' governing bodies, and the advice of professionals including architects with experience in community builds.

The panelled exterior of the building is a solution to the need for insulation while maintaining the original brick walls (internal insulation has been ruled out due to the impact on room size). FDRGT have been advised however that better insulation and reduced running costs would be found with a rebuild. We are yet to establish whether long standing damp problems can be addressed with refurbishment alone.

FDRGT are proposing to seek funding from a number of sources for a major refurbishment programme allowing for a rebuild, together with a small extension to increase the overall size and scope of the building. The choice of materials including external finish, surface area for parking etc. will develop during the more detailed planning process.
